The Trojans were led by Garrett Whitmore with a score of 71, one under par. He was followed by Brad Holley at 80 and Keaton Scanlan and Billy Simmons, each at 81. Midlothian came in with a total score of 313 to tournament champion Clover Hill's 304 and earned the second team spot in the regional tournament.

Monacan came in a close third with 316 points. Scorer's were Austin Gray at 76, Matthew Teachey at 78, Brian Critzer at 79, Nathan Dryden and Braden Cosner, each at 83.

Just two strokes off at 318 was James River. Scoring members included Michael McLean and Drew McLean, each at 77, Nicholas Austin at 79 and Eamon Schwartz at 85.

Besides team members from Midlothian, several James River and Monacan players will compete in the in the Central Region Tournament individually. Gray, Matthew McLean, Drew McLean, Teachey, Austin and Critzer all qualified for the regional tournament.
