

## 2010 All-Metro field hockey team

**Ashley Cureton School:** Deep Run      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Midfield

**The skinny:** The Colonial District player of the year guided the Wildcats to the district title and to the Central Region tournament semifinals. She contributed eight goals and eight assists. Her stick work, toughness and ability to distribute the ball opened the way for high-scoring teammate Amanda Bartlett. Cureton was a first-team all-Central Region and all-state selection.

**What you didn't know:** "I've only been playing field hockey three years, and I've committed to play at Ohio University."

**Dylan Dowdy School:** Cosby      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Sweeper

**The skinny:** The Dominion District player of the year and a first-team all-Central Region pick, Dowdy earned the honor because of superb defense. The Titans, region runners-up for the second year in a row, gave up just three goals in a nine-game winning streak that ended in the region title game.

**What you didn't know:** "I used to play travel soccer and AAU basketball."

**Hailey Flores School:** Thomas Dale      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Midfield

**The skinny:** The Knights' four-year reign as region champs came to an end, but Flores put together an enviable season. She scored 13 goals and had 16 assists. She was selected the Central District and Central Region player of the year and was named first-team all-state.

**What you didn't know:** "My first passion is dance."

**Amanda Kim School:** St. Catherine's      **Year:** Junior      **Position:** Midfield

**The skinny:** Kim shares All-Metro co-player of the year honors and was first-team all-LIS and all-VIS after helping St. Catherine's win the state title for the first time since 2005. She was a key factor in the Saints' ball-control attack and contributed four goals and 15 assists.

**What you didn't know:** "I'm obsessed with Harry Potter books."

**Kelly Keys**      **School:** Monacan      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Back

**The skinny:** Monacan returned to prominence in the Dominion District and Central Region (lost in OT in region semis) for the first time in years thanks in part to Keys' stellar play. She is a defender who can score. Keys was a first-team all-district and all-region choice and was second-team all-state.

**What you didn't know:** "I dance around in the shower."

**Katy May**      **School:** Maggie Walker GS      **Year:** Junior      **Position:** Forward

**The skinny:** Teamed with Cassie Turnage as the high-scoring Green Dragons' primary offensive threats. May delivered 21 goals and 18 assists for the Central Region champions. She was a first-team all-Colonial District and all-Central Region pick and was named to the all-state second team.

**What you didn't know:** "I'm a second-degree black belt in taekwondo."

**Ryland Scott**      **School:** Steward      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Goal keeper

**The skinny:** Scott, a two-time second-team All-Metro keeper, moves up after concluding a five-year career defending the Spartans' goal. She was credited with a career-high 163 saves this season and finished with 746 career saves. She gave up 24 goals and was named all-LIS and all-VIS Division II.

**What you didn't know:** "I live in a house full of vegetarians, but I'm not one."

**Ann Wallace Tazewell**      **School:** Collegiate      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Back

**The skinny:** The Cougars lost some key players from the 2009 state title team, and Tazewell was one of the returnees who stepped into a leadership role. She was the backbone of the defense with her positioning and takeaway skills. She was an all-LIS and all-VIS selection.

**What you didn't know:** "I want to be a wedding planner when I grow up."

**Cassie Turnage** **School:** Maggie Walker GS      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Midfield

**The skinny:** Turnage repeats as a first-team All-Metro pick. She also earned first-team all-Colonial District, all-Central Region and all-state honors for the second year in a row. The Green Dragons' region title was her first.

This season, she scored 19 goals and handed out 25 assists. She is Maggie Walker's all-time scoring leader with 110 goals.

**What you didn't know:** "I know American sign language."

**Kali Vicars**      **School:** St. Catherine's      **Year:** Junior      **Position:** Midfield

**The skinny:** All-Metro co-player of the year Vicars moves up from last year's All-Metro second team. She scored 11 goals and had 18 assists for the state champion Saints. She also earned player of the year accolades.

**What you didn't know:** "I like to draw and paint."

**Helen Warner**      **School:** St. Catherine's      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Back

**The skinny:** The Saints could score but were just as adept on defense (16 goals allowed), and Warner was the central figure as an inside back/sweeper. She was a second-team All-Metro pick last year and was an all-LIS and all-VIS selection this season.

**What you didn't know:** "I went to a camp in Maine, Wyanegonic, from the fifth to ninth grades. It was my life before hockey."

**Emily Wright**      **School:** Collegiate      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Midfield

**The skinny:** Scored three goals and had five assists and set up scoring opportunities on the attack with strong crosses and passing. Selected to the all-LIS and all-VIS teams, she can change the momentum of a game on either end of the field with her speed and athleticism.

**What you didn't know:** "I sleep walk."
