

## 2010 All-Metro girls volleyball team

**Hailey Brooks** School: Atlee Year: Sophomore Position: Setter/outside hitter

**The skinny:** Capital District and Central Region champion Atlee thrived on balance, but Brooks was one of the Raiders' stars. She moves up from last year's All-Metro second team. She was first-team all-district and all-region and second-team all-state after a season in which she had 171 kills, 427 assists, 144 digs, 145 aces and 31 blocks.

**What you didn't know:** "I love to sing, and I want to play the guitar."

**Gabrielle Holt** School: Cosby Year: Sophomore Position: Outside hitter

**The skinny:** Another youngster on the All-Metro first team, Holt was so good she was named Dominion District player of the year. She was a first-team all-Central Region pick. Holt's stats line showed 283 kills, 121 digs, 36 aces and 11 blocks as Cosby advanced to the region semifinals for the first time.

**What you didn't know:** "I come from a big family. I'm one of five kids."

**Chaney LaReau** School: Deep Run Year: Senior Position: Outside hitter

**The skinny:** The Times-Dispatch player of the year has been an All-Metro first-teamer in soccer, too. LaReau was second-team All-Metro in volleyball last year after recovering from her third knee surgery in 14 months. She was named Colonial District and Central Region player of the year. LaReau, who is headed to UNC, is adept on attack (413 kills) and is just as strong as a passer (388 digs). She had 59 aces, 17 blocks and 12 assists. She also earned all-state first-team accolades.

**What you didn't know:** "I got my name from a street sign."

**Krystal Marshall** School: Powhatan Year: Junior Position: Setter

**The skinny:** Powhatan, which didn't lose this season until the Region I final and Group AA tournament quarterfinals, was undefeated against Southside District foes in Marshall's first three years in the starting

lineup. She was the district player of the year and a first-team all-Region I selection. Marshall delivered 587 assists and had 39 blocks, 47 aces and 96 digs.

**What you didn't know:** "I like to knit (scarves), and I like to hunt (deer) with my dad."

**Morgan Reichert**      **School:** Midlothian      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Libero

**The skinny:** Reichert, a first-team all-Dominion District and all-Central Region performer, led the Trojans in digs (300) and serving percentage (98.3). She had 31 aces and chalked up a kill (20) every now and then. Trojan coach Mary Allen says Reichert loves to play defense and doesn't like the ball to hit the floor on her side of the net.

**What you didn't know:** "I got my black belt in karate when I was 11."

**Suzy Rosser**      **School:** Deep Run      **Year:** Senior      **Position:** Middle blocker/opposite

**The skinny:** Rosser has been a steady and versatile contributor for the Wildcats. She produced 212 kills, 70 aces, 39 blocks and 178 digs this season and was honored with first-team all-Colonial District and all-Central Region and second-team all-state status.

**What you didn't know:** "My best friend is my brother Tom."

**Karlie Suber**      **School:** Atlee      **Year:** Sophomore      **Position:** Setter/outside hitter

**The skinny:** Suber, the Capital District player of the year, teamed with Hailey Brooks to give the Raiders a double threat whether setting or hitting. Suber was a first-team all-Central Region choice and helped Atlee win the region title for the first time. Suber, who was a second-team all-state selection, had 160 kills, 150 digs, 366 assists, 92 aces and 21 blocks.

**What you didn't know:** "I have the same heritage as Tiger Woods."
